

Dear Camp Katonim Community,

In light of the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19), we are writing to let you know the approach that Camp Katonim is taking to keep our campers healthy at camp.

In order to ensure a safe experience for everyone at Camp Katonim, we are monitoring this issue carefully and will continue to do so. We have contacted our local public health unit, York Region Public Health, and we are working with the Ontario Camps Association to ensure that we are following best practices. We will continue to look to both the experts in Public Health and the Ontario Camps Association for the most up to date information. We will also be reviewing our policies and procedures as it pertains to communicable diseases and updating them where needed.

At this time, we are expecting Camp Katonim to be fully operational this summer. However, in light of the fluidity of the situation, we are making two changes to our registration policy as it affects fee processing.

1. All outstanding balances will now be due June 1, 2020 instead of May 15, 2020.
2. We are continuing to accept online registrations for Summer 2020 but will no longer require a deposit at time of registration. Instead, all fees are to be paid in full on June 1, 2020.

As always, our campers' health, safety and well-being is of the utmost importance. We will continue to monitor and assess the situation closely and provide you with updates as needed in a timely manner.
